Lettering Policy

Earning a Varsity Letter at Morgan High School is a reflection of hard work both on and off the field. Just being on the field or showing up does not guarantee a varsity letter. You must put work in both on and off the field, during games and practices, in the classroom and in the community. In order to letter you must earn enough points through different criteria. Points will be tracked both during the season and off-season. You must total **1000** points. Here is a breakdown of points:

Team Lift (must be done through the school) - 5 points per lift (88 - March 4 - July 26)

Meet minimum Lifting / Speed Standards - 20 points per standard met

Early Morning Practice - 5 points per practice (22 - March 6 - May 17)

In-Season Practice - 1 point per practice

Academic Eligibility (Turn in Report Card) - 25 points per trimester (up to 75)

FAMILY Service Projects - 20 points per project participated in (up to 100)

FAMILY Activity - 10 points per activity participated in (up to 100)

Team Meetings - 5 points per meeting

Team Camp - 100 points for camp

Fundraisers - 20 points per fundraiser goal met (up to 80)

Other School Sport Participation - 25 points per sport (up to 50)

Clean Locker Room / Team Room - 20 points per cleaning (up to 100)

Play in a Varsity Game - 20 points per game (up to 260)

Do Chains or Clock for JV / Freshman Games - 10 points per game (up to 50)
